2008 Summary of Donated Meat for Southern Maryland FHFH

- 485 Total Number of Deer Donated: (Prince George's, Charles, St. Mary's and Calvert)
- Equals approximately 24,250 pounds of meat
- Equals approximately 97,000 meals for the hungry. (Using ¼ lb. of meat per meal)
Most meat is used in spaghetti and chili or given out as ground.
